### Grant Cover Page

Thank you for your interest in applying for a grant from the Southside School Endowment Fund. Our mission is to enhance the quality of education, culture and experience of Southside School students. In order for the application to be considered, the endowment committee board will need the following:

1. A Completed project narrative
2. Southside School Endowment fund application
3. A proposed budget.

Applications must include all three documents listed above or it will not be considered. An important component of the narrative will be the description of matching funds. Matching funds would be represented by a contribution from some other area to support the project. This does not have to be a monetary contribution but could be labor, donations of any kind, or other support for the project.

### Grant Cycle Funding:

**July 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021** is the deadline for the grant cycle funding applications. All fund applications must be submitted by this date. If there are remaining funds in the grant cycle for that year, a second-round cycle will open. Applications for remaining funds are due by **January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022**.

### Grant Submissions:

### Grant Reporting:

If a grant is funded, the endowment board and Community Foundation will need an end of the year summary impact report describing the project, the funding use and the impact on students or school culture. The form and the guidelines for the impact report will be provided with the grant award notification.
